- Due to reductions in funding, we will be charging participants to drop off their waste
- 3. The cost will be \$25.00 per vehicle for household clean sweep.
- The cost will be \$25.00 per vehicle for Agriculture clean sweep which includes the 1st 200 pounds of hazardous waste material
- At the time of preregistration, a drop-off time will be scheduled and further information given regarding safe handling of hazardous materials
- 6. Put items in a box lined with a garbage bag to eliminate spillage. Bring them to the Richland County HWY shop at your appointment time Payment is due at this time
